1. 78th ASSOCIATION ANNUAL CONVENTION: The Association's 78th Annual Convention will be held in Orlando, FL. The dates for the Convention are 14-17 August 2024. The Rosen Centre Hotel, 9840 International Drive, Orlando, FL is once again hosting the Association. The Association has held numerous Conventions at this awesome Hotel and Convention Center and anyone who has attended in the past knows that a great time will be had by all.





Association Registration is \$195 per person and includes food, snacks and drinks in the hospitality room, as well as two formal dinners — the Memorial Dinner and the Airborne Banquet. Registration must be received by July 25. The registration fee increases to \$225 on July 26.

The Rosen Centre is offering room rates at \$94 per night, plus tax. The hotel reservations cutoff date is July 10, 2024. Starting July 11, the room rate goes up to \$106 per night. Hotel rates are for registered members only. Please make your reservations early as

- 7. NOMINATIONS FOR NATIONAL OFFICERS: We encourage Chapters to begin looking at prospective nominees for the 2025 Board of Directors. These are very important positions within the Association and ones that will allow members to assist the Association in its continued success.
- **8.** <u>CURRENT PROJECTS OF THE ASSOCIATION</u>: This is a list of some of the Projects the Association has approved for working on in 2024:
 - **a.** Support for Families of 82nd Airborne Division Fallen Troopers of the 82nd Airborne Division and WIAs: Assistance to the 82nd Airborne Division Association Wounded Warrior Fund through direct response to needs of Families immediately following the loss or injury of an 82nd Trooper. Provide educational scholarships to Spouses and Children of Fallen Troopers through the 82nd Fallen Trooper Family Fund.
 - **b.** Recognition of the Jumpmaster, NCO, and Trooper of the Year: Every year our Association recognizes the accomplishments of the 82nd Airborne Divisions Jumpmaster, Non-Commissioned Officer, and Trooper of the Year at our annual dinner during AAW. On the final evening of AAW, the Leadership and Troopers of the 82nd Airborne Division join the 82nd Airborne Division Association Members as we present these outstanding Troopers with awards to recognize their accomplishments (accomplished through Association and corporate donations).
 - c. All American Adventure 2024: The plan is to send twenty 82nd Airborne Division Troopers on a



4-day resiliency trip to the Catskill Mountains for fishing, hiking, biking and numerous other activities. Aimed at helping Troopers in reintegration after deployment, this project uses donations from Association Members and Chapters, and Corporate sponsorship to accomplish this project. This trip usually takes place in June, provided we are able to secure funding for our Troopers. Help us in providing an avenue to assist our 82nd Troopers in their resiliency during their redeployment process.

d. <u>Airborne Night Out:</u> Our Association is coordinating with local sporting teams to give both our Active Duty Troopers and Veterans a much deserved "Night Out". Our veterans and Active Duty Troopers work hard and deserve a little recreation from time to time. These Troopers will be able to come together and celebrate the comradery shared between previous and current Paratroopers while enjoying a catered meal and ball game at no charge to the participants.





e. <u>Holiday Troop Support 2024:</u> This will be our 9th Annual "Holiday Troop Support" and we will again provide over 1000 meals to young Troopers and their Families over the Thanksgiving and Holiday Season to insure the Families of young 82nd Troopers have bountiful Holiday meals over the Holiday Season. *These events will be conducted November and December 2024.  - g. 20 July 2024 2024 Convention Delegate nominations.
- **12.** <u>IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR CHAPTERS</u>: Chapters need to be cautious when using images, cartoons, etc., that are found on the internet, on your websites, newsletters, etc. If it has a copyright, you can be leaving yourselves open to litigation. This has happened to a Chapter recently and we hope to avoid other Chapters from having to deal with this issue. Always search to ensure items do not have a copyright prior to using.





- **13.** <u>USE OF ASSOCIATION NAME FOR POLITICAL STANCES:</u> The 82nd Airborne Division Association shall *in no way* use official communications of any type to relay political stances. This includes, but is not limited to, correspondence using Association letterhead, email addresses, websites or any other social media. Members will not make any political statements while representing themselves as 82nd Airborne Division Association Members, nor shall any Association or Chapter meetings be used in any way to relay political opinions or party affiliations. Neither the Association nor any of its Chapters will discriminate against or support any organization solely on the grounds of their political standings. We are not in the business of politics and will not support any political organizations.
- 14. <u>CHAPTER REQUIREMENTS</u>: There are required Chapter documents that must be sent to the National Office. All required reports are listed in this bulletin and are referenced as REQUIRED. **Required Chapter documents are** *not optional* **and are required for the Chapters to maintain their non-profit 501(c)4 status**. Any Chapter that does not submit the required documents will be reported to the Board of Directors, and be subject to closure by the Board of Directors. There are only a few documents required to be submitted every year by the Chapter Chairman, and they must be completed. We have created a standard form for all required annual reports. Master forms can be found on our website at the following link: https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html).

If the necessary information is not included in the reports or the standardized reports are not used, the Chapter will be asked to resubmit with the required information or on the correct form.

- 15. <u>2024 CHAPTER OFFICERS (REQUIRED)</u>: DEADLINE: PAST DUE. 1 February 2024. The list of the Chapter Officers that will be serving in the year of 2024 should include, name, position and contact information. *If your Chapter elects Officers within the year of 2024, you must notify the National Office immediately so that we can update our records*. We have created a standard form (click or go to link for form: https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html). Please use only that form. **These documents must be submitted every year whether there are changes or not.**
- **16.** <u>2023/2024 CHAPTER ACTIVITIES REPORTS (REQUIRED)</u>: DEADLINE: PAST DUE. 1 **February 2024.** Per the Association By-Laws, "a report of the dates and places of all meetings and activities held or sponsored by the Chapter" throughout the 2023 year, and a "tentative" schedule of the Chapter's meetings and activities for 2024, is a requirement. We have created a standard form (click or go to the link for form: https://82ndairborneassociation.org/resources.html). Please use only that format.
- 17. 2023 CHAPTER FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (*REQUIRED*): DEADLINE: 10 April 2024. 2023 Chapter Financial Statements, which are required to be furnished by all Association Chapters for inclusion in the Association Group Federal Income Tax Return, have been emailed to the Chapter email accounts in January 2024. If your Chapter files separately, you must notify the National Office on Chapter letterhead signed by the Chapter Chairman, stating that the Chapter has filed their taxes separately from the Association. The financial statements can be emailed to *execsec@82ndairborneassociation.org* or mailed to the office.

Those Chapters that failed to submit financial reports for 2022 and 2023 will receive a letter, from the National Office, announcing the Board of Directors intent to review the Chapters status for possible revocation of the Chapter charter through the 82nd Airborne Division Association.
